

WINEMAKER NOTES

The deceptively light color of the 2017 Grenache - Larner Vineyard doesn't let on that this wine is packed with unctuous candied red fruit aromatics and juicy flavors on the palate. The concentrated holiday spice notes and fine-grained tannins give this wine a mouth-coating and food friendly quality.

2017 VINTAGE

Drought conditions began to lessen. We received our first significant rainfall since 2011/2012 in the winter between 2016 and 2017. Not nearly enough to get out of the drought, but enough to provide relief to our seriously stressed vines. We experienced another warm spring and summer, but not as extreme as 2013-2016. Despite the challenging conditions, the fruit was in good condition at harvest.

THE LARNER VINEYARD SITE

Planted in 1999, Larner Vineyard is situated amongst the beautiful rolling hills of Ballard Canyon in the Santa Ynez Valley. At approximately 680 feet in elevation, this organically-farmed vineyard is planted to almost all Rhône varieties, including six acres of Grenache (4 blocks, 4 clones). The soil is composed of Marina sand roughly four feet shallow on top of a chalk bedrock, intermixed with conglomerate hardpan.
