


2020 CARBONIC SYRAH RANCHO BOA VISTA VINEYARD SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2020 Syrah - Carbonic from Rancho Boa Vista Vineyard is an electrically magenta, powerfully aromatic, mineral-driven wine that can be served cellar temperature or chilled on a hot day. On the nose there are notes of pepper, fresh, dark fruit and chaparral, on the palate a mouth-coating texture and light, fine-grained tannins support a very pure red fruit flavor of pomegranate that lingers with a long finish. This is a perfect summer grilling wine, and will compliment anything that comes off the barbecue.

2020 VINTAGE

2020 was a whirlwind harvest in a less-than-normal year. Fruit came in relatively early due to a warm summer, but fruit quality was incredibly high. With decent rainfall, vines were healthy and a warm spring helped usher in a balanced crop. Chardonnay and Pinot began ripening in late August. A bit of heat at the beginning of harvest kicked things off with a bang, but moderate temperatures throughout the fall kept Rhônes on the vine a little longer. The 2020 wines show good flavor concentration and depth, while still retaining their balance and freshness.

SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

The wine region of Santa Barbara County is located north of the city of Santa Barbara and includes the Santa Ynez Valley and Santa Maria Valley. A defining feature of the region that makes it ideal for grape growing are the transverse, (east-to-west running) mountain ranges that funnel the marine climate inland. The marine fog and wind have a moderating effect on the vines prolonging the growing season and providing a longer hang time for the fruit.

ACCOLADES

The wine dances across the palate with açai and boysenberry flavors, as lavender gives delicate hints into the fresh finish. - Matt Kettmann
