Upfront aromatics of dark fruit and a blend of savory and sweet herbs (herbs de Provence). Generous and giving on the palate with a glossy texture and mouthfeel. On the back end, the wine tightens up as the structure becomes more apparent, providing precision and length on the finish.

2021 VINTAGE

LA ENCANTADA VINEYARD

La Encantada is one of the famed Sandford Vineyards along with Sandford and Benedict, Rinconada, and La Encantada. This site reflects historic Santa Barbara winemaking right here. And, naturally, this is another vineyard that we were really honored and fortunate to be able to work with. Our block in particular is one of the older blocks, planted in the back of the vineyard. The soil is super sandy. The vines are 20 years plus years old.
